Clinton	Clinton County Park District	\$155,696.00	<i>Clinton County Friendship Trail -28 miles acquisition of a utility corridor from Wilmington in Clinton County through Washington Court House in Fayette County to the Pickaway County line. This acquisition will link directly into the trail acquisition for Pickaway County from the 2009 COTF funding round.</i>
Darke	Darke County Park District	\$220,000.00	<i>Dayton Power & Light Abandoned Rail Corridor Acquisition -The acquisition of 16 miles of abandoned rail corridor from Dayton Power & Light. This will link Darke County to the Great Miami River Recreational Trail System in Miami County.</i>
Sandusky	Sandusky County Park District	\$375,000.00	<i>North Coast Inland Trail, Clyde-Bellevue -Engineering & construction of a 4.7 miles, 10ft wide, multi-use, non motorized, paved extension of the North Coast Inland Trail between the cities of Clyde and Bellevue. This trail is the final Sandusky Co. section in the multi-county North Coast Inland Trail.</i>
Hamilton	Mill Creek Restoration Project	\$405,000.00	<i>Queen City-South Mill Creek Greenway Trail-Phase 3A -A trail extension for 2,800 linear feet to the north along the west side of Mill Creek and between the river and Salway Park. Section 2 is 1,900 linear feet extension to the south along the east side of mill Creek connection the Mill Creek bridge in the South, along the East side of Mill Creek, connecting to the Mill Creek Road bridge in the South Cummingsville neighborhood.</i>

Greene	Beavercreek	\$204,523.00	<i>Rotary Park Connector</i> - Acquisition, engineering, and construction of an 4600 linear foot segment that will connect "landlocked" housing developments, regional bikeways, downtown Beaver Creek, businesses, schools, and amenities. This trail will go through 2 existing parks.
Fairfield	Lancaster, Lancaster Parks & Recreation	\$373,605.00	<i>Lancaster</i> -Phase IV is a 2.30 mile Northern extension of the Lancaster City Bike Trail.
Stark	Stark County Park District	\$456,000.00	<i>Plain Center Trail</i> -To develop 4.5 miles by 10 ft wide limestone trail north from the Stark Co. Park District's Plain Center Trail in Plain Twp & adding 2 stoplights with pedestrians crossings on Easton St. & Schneider St.
Licking	Newark	\$139,000.00	<i>Church Street Bike Trail Connector</i> -Construction of bike trails, bike lanes, a mid-block pedestrian/bike crossing, and a trail head. There will be 3,300 LF of multi-use trail and 8,800 LF of bike lanes along Church Street, 4th Street, Market Street, 1st Street, and Main Street. One mid-block pedestrian/bicyclist crossing located at Church Street at the Board of Education service drive across from the YMCA, a trailhead facility with restrooms and bicycle parking.
Franklin	Gahanna, Department of Parks & Recreation	\$366,021.00	<i>Big Walnut Creek Trail, Section 1 & 2</i> -Note: This project has been recommended for funding out of the RTP program in the amount of \$73,116.00 . The project includes two sections of new paved trail totaling 6,316 square feet, an outlook point, culvert/drainage, fencing, signage, site furnishings and the site preparation.

Miami	Miami County Park District	\$147,209.00	Great Miami River Recreational Trail-Little to Eden -Construction of 1.6 miles of 10 ft wide asphalt path along the Great Miami River Recreational Trail. This project will connect to the City of Troy trail system with a 2 mile section in Miami County built in 2009.
Ross	Ross County Park District	\$307,854.00	Tricounty Triangle Trail/Adena Recreational Trail-To apply 3 inches of asphalt (two courses) to six miles of improved, abandoned B & O Railroad property linking to asphalted trail on each end. This is a connector project that will connect two portions of the Tricounty Triangle Trail.
Athens	Athens County Regional Planning Commission	\$182,163.00	The Plains & High School Connector-Construction of .79 miles of asphalt paved bikeway to connect the existing Hockholding Adena Bikeway with the Athens High School and the unincorporated area of the Plains.
Columbiana	Columbiana County Park District	\$120,355.00	Little Beaver Creek Greenway Trail-1.46 miles of additional trail for the Little Beaver Creek Greenway Trail in Lisbon, which is one part of the 4 county Great Ohio Lake-to-River Greenway Trail.
Butler	Butler County Commissioners	\$500,000.00	Great Miami River Recreation Trail-This project will construct a 9,900 ft long, 10ft wide asphalt recreation trail along the tow path of the Miami & Erie Canal in Fairfield Township, Butler County. The trail segment is a segment of the 90 mile plus Great Miami River recreational trail.

Franklin	Columbus Recreation and Parks Department	\$410,000.00	<i>Alum Creek Trail - Sunbury Ridge to Brittany Hills</i> -Develop a 0.64 mile segment of the Alum Creek Trail from Sunbury to Brittany Hills. This project will have one bridge, which will cross over Alum Creek near mock road, a cross walk, and a trailhead parking area.
Cuyahoga	Euclid	\$350,000.00	<i>Euclid Waterfront Improvements Plan-Lake Erie Waterfront Trail</i> - Acquisition of 8 parcels of land for the purpose of constructing a Lake Erie waterfront trail which will connect to Sims Park, Downtown Euclid, Euclid Marina. This project is part of the overall City of Euclid redevelopment plan.
Cuyahoga	Cleveland Metro Parks	\$468,000.00	<i>West Creek All-Purpose Greenway Trail</i> -To construct 3,415 L.F. of greenway trail, a trail bridge over West Creek, and additional signage to the existing West Creek greenway all-purpose Trail system. This development will form the spine for future connections to regional & statewide trails such as Towpath Trail & Ohio to Erie.
Ottawa	Danbury Township Board of Trustees	\$126,343.00	<i>Meadowbrook Marsh North Trail</i> - <i>Note: This project has been recommend for funding out of RTP program in the amount \$43,317.00.</i> Engineering & construction of an ADA accessible 3,855 L.F., 8ft wide asphalt paved non-motorized trail. It will connect to an existing 3,150 ft ADA accessible asphalt trail, marsh overlook, and nature trails that were constructed with Clean Ohio Conservation Funding.

Medina	Medina	\$479,938.00	<i>Champion Creek Trail-Note: This project has been recommended for funding out of the RTP program in the amount of \$109,260.00. The existing Champion Creek Trail will be extended by 4,600 LF of 10 wide asphalt path through the city of Medina. This project will also acquire .684 acres of trail easements from local businesses and a church.</i>
Henry	Henry County Park District	\$53,250.00	<i>Miami & Erie Towpath Trail-To construct two bridges in Henry County, the western bridge is located .25 mile east of Napoleon on State Route 424 and the eastern bridge 1 mile west of Texas, OH on US 24.The West end the trail will connect to the towpath trail of Independence Dam State Park. The Eastern part of this trail will connect to other trails in the North Turkey Foot area of Mary Jane Thurston State Park.</i>
Knox	Gambier	\$51,675.00	<i>Community Center Trail-The project will construct a scenic .38 mile, 8 ft wide multi-use asphalt trail and a multi-recreational facility trailhead that will provide access to the proposed trail system.</i>
Delaware	Orange Township Parks	\$350,000.00	<i>Lewis Center Rail Trail North-Phase 3-Phase 3 will construct 6624 L.F. of trail from Glen Oak Park going north to Franklin Street in Lewis Center.</i>
Portage	Portage Park District	\$348,280.00	<i>Berlin Lake Trail-Berlin Lake Trail is a 2.2 mile multi-use purposed trail. The surface will be crushed lime stone and have trail-head facilities including parking lot, signage, information kiosk, and the renovation of a concrete bridge across Berlin Lake.</i>

Vinton	Buckeye Trail Association, Inc	\$182,583.00	<i>The Buckeye Trail-"Pretty Run"-BTA is requesting funding for the acquisition of 190 acres of land to protect 3.5 miles of existing Buckeye Trail. The "Petty Run" property consists of 4 contiguous parcels of land that will provide protection of the rail corridor. This is an important step in eventually connecting disparate segments of the BT in Hocking Hills SP/SF and Tar Hollow SF.</i>
Cuyahoga	Parkworks Inc.	\$88,524.00	<i>Lake Link Trail & Greenway-Acquisition of one parcel of land at the southernmost ends of the planned 1.5 mile Lake Link Trail to connect the Towpath Trail with Lake Erie.</i>
Licking	Pataskala	\$189,339.00	<i>Cross Town Line, Phase I-Note: This projects has been recommended for funding out of the RTP program in the amount of \$50,490.00. Construction of an 8 ft. wide 3,400 LF between the Bright Water Sub-division and Pataskala Ridge Subdivision along with one wooded bridge.</i>
Darke	Darke County Park District	\$178,000.00	<i>Darke Co. to Miami Co. Connector - Phase 2 - Beyond the First Mile -This project is the second priority for the COTF FY 2010 funding round. To construct a 4.3 mile trail of which 1.6 miles will be new trail construction and the remaining trail will be lane markings, signage, and resurfacing of an existing bridge.</i>

Hamilton	Woodlawn	\$460,200.00	<i>West Fork Mill Creek Greenway Trail/Woodlawn Extension</i> -This project involves acquiring property from one private owner and a donation of property from a local business. The development of a trailhead (parking lot), 1,100 L.F. of new trail, and the constructing a segmental block retaining wall. This wall will add support to the trail which runs along Mill Creek. This trail will connect 2 existing pieces of trail that run through the Village of Woodlawn and connecting to the Villages local water park and community center.
Lucas	Sylvania	\$430,000.00	<i>Sylvania River Trail</i> -The construction of 1.3 miles of pedestrian/bike path that will run through the City of Sylvania along the Ottawa river and Ten Mile Creek.
Summit	Akron	\$173,186.00	<i>Northside Train Station Connector</i> - To acquire 2.9 acres of property and construct 1100 L.F. of asphalt trail. It will link the Towpath Trail at the Beech Street Trail Head to the historic Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad North side Train Station.
