This burn will be conducted according to a prescribed burn / site plan that addresses Landowner Information, , Description of Site, Description of Fuels, Weather requirements (surface wind speed and direction, temperature range, relative humidity range, mixing heights, transport wind speed and direction)Personnel and Equipment Needs, Site monitoring plans (site preparation, holding crew placement, mop-up, and post burn evaluation), Notifications to be made in the event of an emergency, Worker and public safety considerations, and Contingency plans.

Applicants are required to provide the division:

1. A record of a completed burn within 120 days. Records should be submitted on the Prescribed Fire Reporting Form located on the division's website <http://forestry.ohiodnr.gov/prescribedfire> .
2. A narrative record and any associated documents of any significant escaped fires that result in the response of a fire department or other emergency response agency OR any escape that could result in criminal or civil actions within 30 days.

It is the Applicant's responsibility to provide notification to or request appropriate permits from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and notify the local fire department with jurisdiction and the division of forestry on the day of the burn.

Failure to report the above may result in denial of future waiver requests.
