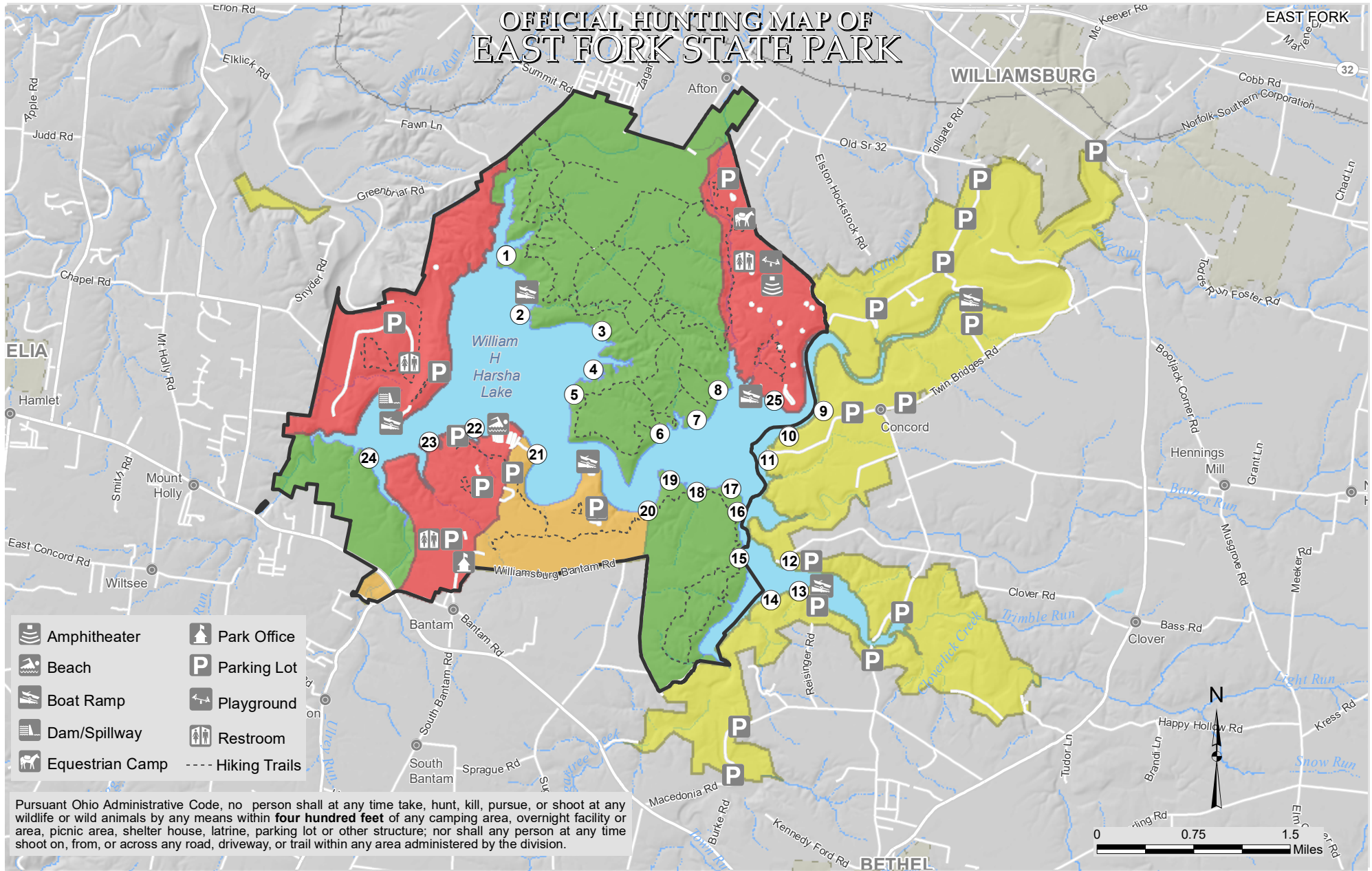


OFFICIAL HUNTING MAP OF EAST FORK STATE PARK



Pursuant Ohio Administrative Code, no person shall at any time take, hunt, kill, pursue, or shoot at any wildlife or wild animals by any means within **four hundred feet** of any camping area, overnight facility or area, picnic area, shelter house, latrine, parking lot or other structure; nor shall any person at any time shoot on, from, or across any road, driveway, or trail within any area administered by the division.
