Saturday, October 16th

- 11AM Wildlife Invasion** - Meet at the Lodge for a close look at Ohio's wildlife.
- 1PM Annual Fall Colors Hike** - Meet at the Nature Center to walk through the changing forest. Please wear appropriate footwear. Bring your vehicle; we will drive to the trail.

Saturday, October 23rd

- 11AM Wildlife Invasion** - Meet at the Lodge for a close look at Ohio's wildlife.
