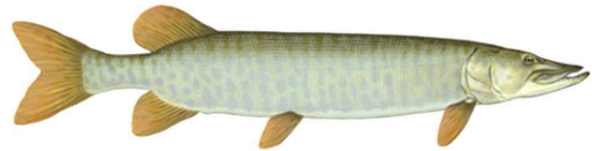




# Ohio's Muskellunge Program

### Muskellunge ("Muskie") in Ohio

- Top predator native to Ohio's rivers and streams.
- Grow fast in Ohio reservoirs; reaching 50+ inches.
- Highly prized by anglers for their size and fight.
- State record is 55.1 pounds and 50.25 inches long.
- Numerous clubs in Ohio are dedicated to Muskellunge fishing.



### Muskellunge Program and Stocking

- The goal of the Muskellunge program is to create and maintain trophy fishing opportunities.
- Annual stocking and voluntary catch reporting have allowed the Division of Wildlife to develop quality fisheries in nine Ohio reservoirs.
- 20,000 Muskellunge are annually reared and stocked by the Kincaid and London State Fish Hatcheries.
