BAT PERMIT HOLDERS: Please enter bat data into the Bat Diversity Database rather than the standard Wildlife Diversity Database. Column headings are customized for bat data. The data will later be put into the Wildlife Diversity Database.

1. On first use, copy and rename this Excel spreadsheet to your hard drive. Include the permit holder's last name and permit number in the file name (ex. Smith19-032.xls). Keep the original Excel file as a template in case you exceed 10,000 records, necessitating a second copy.
2. Blue fields are required info and gray fields are desired information, but not required. Format and columns should not be changed. Species names must be the scientific names (Latin), not common names, with NO abbreviations. Latitude and longitude should be in decimal degrees.
3. **For those individuals that are not identified, please include as many details and measurements as possible.**
4. Use drop-down lists where provided (e.g., capture method, county, age, habitat); use categories furnished in the drop-down menus, do not make up your own.
5. Repetitive information can be copied and pasted.
6. An example has been provided in row 2 and is shaded in light gray with red script.
7. If you don't have data for a given field, don't put anything there.
