2022-23 PROPOSED BAG LIMITS

TWO DEER COUNTY	A hunter may harvest no more than two deer in a two-deer county during the 2022-23 season. A hunter may use two either-sex permits, two deer management permits, or one of each.
THREE DEER COUNTY	A hunter may harvest no more than three deer in a three-deer county during the 2022-23 season. A hunter may use three either-sex permits, three deer management permits, or any combination.
FOUR DEER COUNTY	A hunter may harvest no more than four deer in a four-deer county during the 2022-23 season. A hunter may use four either-sex permits, four deer management permits, or any combination.

Hunters may not exceed an individual county bag limit. Only one deer may be antlered. The statewide bag limit is six deer.
