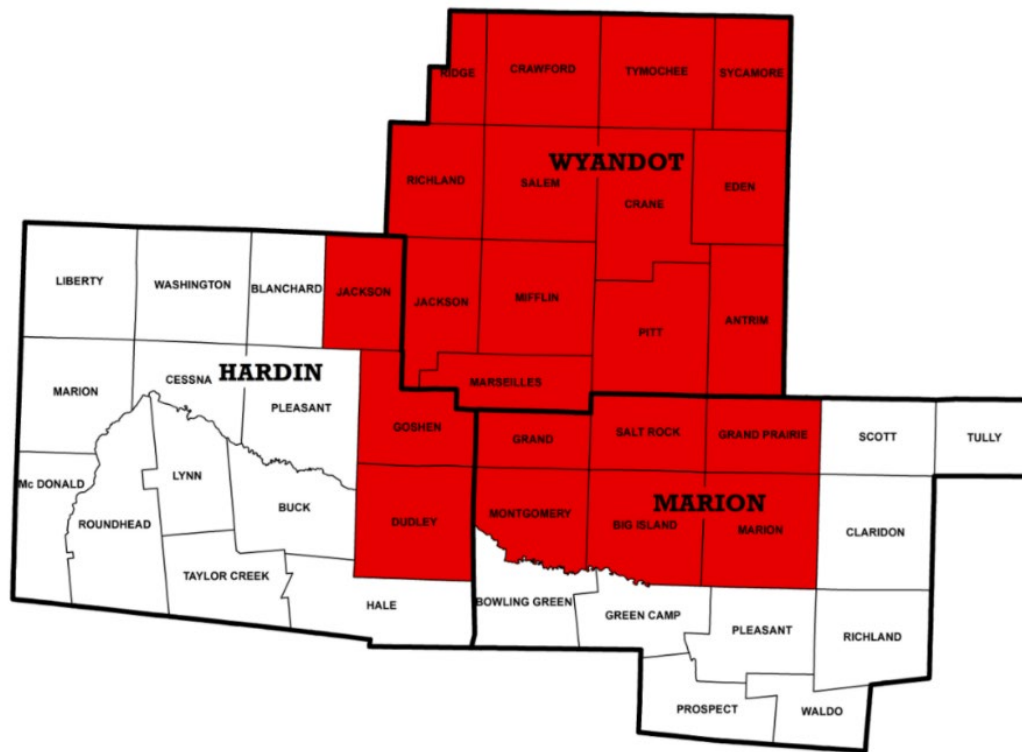


Disease Surveillance Area (DSA) 2021-01

Under Ohio Administrative Code 1501:31-19-03, The chief of the division of wildlife may establish disease surveillance areas within the state if chronic wasting disease or bovine tuberculosis is detected in a member of the cervidae family. Following is a current list of disease surveillance areas and links to pertinent regulations that will affect those that plan on hunting in and transporting deer out of a DSA.
